DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT | *JOSIAH JUNQUEIRA SPENCER*

Directing *HOLD* was a deeply personal journey for me, shaped by my recent life experiences. The script resonated with me, capturing the layers of tension, unspoken emotions, and the blend of mundane and profound conversations that arise during challenging times.

HOLD explores how difficult moments can foster deeper empathy and personal growth within a family.

Visually, I aimed to reflect the story's subtextual nature. The rainy morning setting forces us to always look to find the characters, mirroring their unclear journey. This slightly abstracted reality allows for the final scene, evoking a sense of something beautiful and unbelievable happening, despite the difficult circumstances.

I hope the audience leaves with a sense of hope, recognizing that life's difficult moments often lead to a deeper understanding and appreciation of those around us.



WRITER'S STATEMENT | *KELLY STRANDEMO*

HOLD was written during the second COVID-19 lockdown in New York City. It was a time when the city, like the world at large, was becoming increasingly aware of our desperate need for human connection, especially when it was seemingly impossible to have. The only other time I'd ever experienced anything remotely like that was when my father had cancer over a decade prior to the pandemic. A moment that happened during that first period of life-changing external circumstances became the seed around which the fictional story of *HOLD* grew.

HOLD is about family; its complexities and ever-shifting dynamics. It is about singular moments in time that can forever alter our perspectives and our relationships. It's about both the fragility and fortitude of connection. And ultimately, *HOLD* is about the unseen, daily elements reverberating through our lives and bodies that span the gaps of human experience and somehow, mysteriously, unite us.

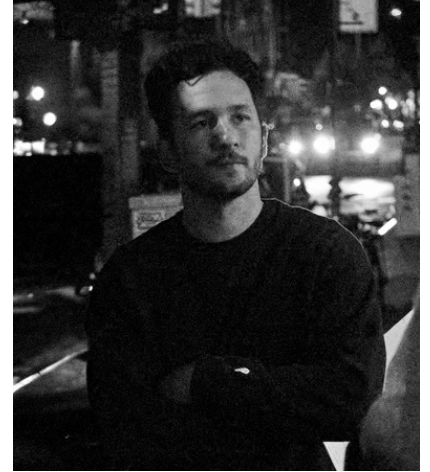

She has played recurring characters on *THE GILDED AGE*, *NEW AMSTERDAM*, *AMERICAN HORROR*, and *GREY'S ANATOMY* with guest stars on *THE MARVELOUS MRS. MAISEL*, *BULL*, and *GIRLS*. She won the Emmy Award for Outstanding Guest Actress as "Katie Sipowicz" in *NYPD BLUE*.

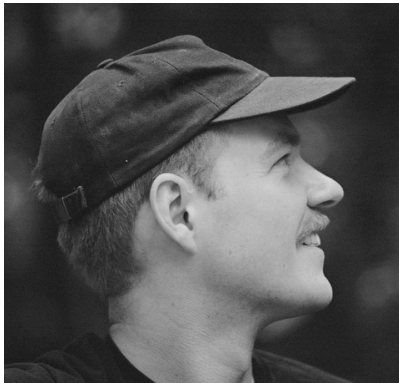
HEIRESS PRODUCTIONS | EXECUTIVE PRODUCER

Color has always been a driving force in Kath Raisch's life. Her love of photography and darkroom printing eventually led her to Company 3. Her impressive feature credits include AFTERSUN, which landed director Charlotte Wells top awards at the 2022 Cannes and Berlin film festivals; a total of six long- and short-form projects for Tribeca 2022; SHAPELESS (Tribeca 2021); BLACK BEAR for Sundance 2020; PREMATURE, which premiered at the 2019 Sundance Film Festival to acclaim and was subsequently picked up by IFC Films; the powerful drama Port Authority, which premiered in the 2019 Cannes Film Festival's UN CERTAIN REGARD section to raves; THE MOTHER starring Jennifer Lopez for Netflix; THE CLOCK for Hulu. She has also colored outstanding feature-length documentaries including the FRAMING JOHN DELOREAN, and LA92, both of which premiered to excellent reviews at this past Tribeca Film Festival. Previously, she's colored a wide assortment of short films that have premiered at the major film festivals as well as Oscar-nominated (2017) short MY NEPHEW EMMETT.
